



Texas Adventure ... Cowboys, Mission Control, and the Riverwalk

10 Days – 9 Nights – September 22 to October 1, 2026

Dallas, Houston, San Antonio



Join us as we head south to the Lone Star State where we will experience the rich culture, delicious cuisine, and fascinating history that Texas has to offer. Explore the old west cowboy spirit in Dallas and Fort Worth, stroll the iconic river walk in San Antonio and visit the NASA Space Center in Houston for a behind-the-scenes look at spaceflight. Enjoy a guided highlights tour of Dallas, including Old Red Courthouse, Dealy Plaza & JFK assassination site, JFK Memorial, Visit the Sixth Floor Museum overlooking Dealy Plaza (if available), Tour Sourdough Ranch (the setting of the TV show Dallas). Tour the AT&T Stadium (home of the Dallas Cowboys). We will travel to Fort Worth, known as "Cowtown", where we will enjoy a tour that includes the Cultural District and a tour through Billy Bob's of Texas, the world's largest honky tonk. We will see a cattle drive of longhorns that parade right down Exchange Boulevard. Our tour ends at the Stockyards where you will have time to browse the shops and have dinner on your own before heading to the Stockyards Rodeo. Our San Antonio visit will include The Alamo, Mission Trail, Market Square, the King William Historic District, the Governor's Palace and more. Then off to enjoy an exciting Riverboat cruise on the Paseo Del Rio where you'll have the best view of the Riverwalk. In Houston we will tour the Space Center Houston where we will go behind the scenes of America's exciting space program.

Day 1: Depart from Oconomowoc aboard your motorcoach and travel to Springfield, Missouri for overnight lodging. Dinner is on your own this evening.

Day 2: After breakfast, check out and travel to Dallas, Texas, a modern metropolis in northern Texas. Check into your hotel for a 3-night stay and prepare for **dinner at the Saltgrass Restaurant**.

Day 3: After breakfast, meet your local guide for a **full day of touring to include Dallas highlights**, such as Old Red Courthouse, Dealy Plaza and the JFK assassination site, the JFK Memorial, Dallas City Hall, and the **Dallas Heritage Village**. You will have time to visit the Sixth Floor JFK museum, located in the former Texas School Book Depository and overlooking Dealy Plaza (if available). The story of John F. Kennedy's assassination is told through thousands of incredible TV and radio broadcasts, photographs, manuscripts, documents and artifacts that are displayed within the Museum. Your tour will end on the **Southfork Ranch**, the television home of "The Ewings" from the show "Dallas". After a tour of the Ewing Mansion, depart for **dinner at Mangia Bistro**.

Day 4: Following breakfast at your hotel, meet your guide for a tour of the **AT&T Stadium**, which is not only the **home of the Dallas Cowboys** but also the largest domed structure and an art museum. After your tour, continue to **Fort Worth for a tour**. Fort Worth is known as "Cowtown". Your tour will include such sights as the Cultural District and a tour through **Billy Bob's of Texas**, the world's largest honky tonk. You'll see a cattle drive of longhorns that parade right down Exchange Boulevard. The tour ends at the **Stockyards** where you will have time to browse the shops and have dinner on your own. Tonight's highlight is the **Stockyards Rodeo**.

Day 5: After breakfast, check out and travel to **San Antonio** in south central Texas which features a rich colonial heritage. Upon arrival, check into your hotel for a 2-night stay. The evening is free to enjoy the **Riverwalk** ... a public park featuring European-style passages with sidewalk cafes, galleries, boutiques and nightclubs. Dinner is on your own while at the Riverwalk.

Day 6: After breakfast meet our tour guide for a **full day of touring San Antonio's highlights** to include **The Alamo**, site of the Battle of Alamo in 1836, **Mission Trail**, Market Square, the King William Historic District, the Governor's Palace and more. The group will enjoy an exciting **Riverboat Cruise on the Paseo Del Rio** where you will have the best view of the Riverwalk. This evening's dinner will be at the **Azuca restaurant**.

Day 7: After breakfast, check out and travel to **Houston**, known for being the world capital of space exploration, air conditioning, the international energy industry, petroleum exploration, and capital punishment. Arrive early afternoon for lunch on your own and **to tour Space Center Houston**, the official visitor's center of the Lyndon B. Johnson Space Center. Be inspired by the wonders of space exploration and go behind the scenes of America's exciting space program. Later, check into our hotel and enjoy dinner on your own.

Day 8: After breakfast, check out and travel to Little Rock, AR for overnight lodging. Dinner is on your own.

Day 9: Enjoy breakfast, then check out and travel to St. Louis, MO to visit the Gateway Arch for a tram ride to the top. Afterwards, check into your hotel. Dinner is included this evening.

Day 10: After breakfast, check out and travel back to Oconomowoc with lasting memories of our Texas Adventure.
